



- Please note: If candidate applies for Verified Photocopy and/ or Re-evaluation he/she is not permitted to apply for Verification of Marks in Absentia.
- Schools are required to pay the fees through PAYMENT GATEWAY provided on the Goa Board Website.
- The Head of Institution should categorically inform the candidates that in case of Verified Photocopy, total marks and any unassessed answers will be verified. If unassessed answers are found the same will be sent for revaluation without additional fees.
- However, candidate may apply for Re-evaluation if desires after obtaining photocopy before the lapse of last date for Re-evaluation.
- No candidate will be permitted to apply for Verified Photocopy/ Verification in Absentia/ Re-evaluation of answer-book beyond the dates specified in this Circular.

- No result will be handed over to the candidate/s or parents at the distribution centres even after producing authority letter from the school.
- Parents should not visit this office for any type of discrepancies pertaining to the results.
- Private/ITI candidates to collect the marksheets from the Asst Secretary of this office.

- ◆ Supplementary examination will be conducted by the Board for the candidates who are placed :
 - 1) Needs Improvement category (in more than 2 subjects).
 - 2) ATKT category (Needs improvement in one or two subjects).
 - 3)Or candidates who have withdrawn their Examination form.
- ◆ Candidates who have secured overall ' H ' or ' I ' Gradein the subject have to clear that subject in the forthcoming boards examination.
- ◆ The tentative date for Supplementary exam is 10th June 2024


